“ ... Disorders which symptoms can be treated with or which can be cured by the aloe-derived polysaccharide prepared according to the invention include: sun-burn irritation, poison ivy irritation, poison oak irritation, gastric ulcers, wound healing, cancer, viral infection, immunosuppression, immune deficiency, microbial infection, inflammation, AIDS, neuralgia, ulcerative colitis, tuberculosis, cryptosporidiosis, fungal infection, leukemia, chronic rheumatoid arthritis, acute rheumatoid arthritis, depression, anxiety, alopecia, rheumatic fever, influenza, cystic fibrosis, malnutrition, asthma, lupus erythematosus, allergy, hypercholesterolemia, poisonous animal or insect bites, premalignant skin lesions, tumors, Kaposi's sarcoma, hepatic tumor, malnutrition, malabsorption syndrome, multiple sclerosis, chronic fatigue syndrome, measles, inflammatory bowel disease, cutaneous ulcers, pneumocystis carinii infection, herpes, iridovirus infection, poxvirus infection, hepadnavirus infection, orthomyxovirus infection, paramyxovirus infection, and wound cleansing. ...”
